### J CLASS SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### Amendment 2

Delete and replace SI 13.3 with the following:

13.3 For Thursday races only, refer to Exhibit 10 for Windward / Leeward course configuration and buoy colors. For Friday, Saturday and Sunday coastal races, the starting line will be between a staff displaying a large orange flag on the race committee signal boat and the course side of a yellow inflatable cylinder. The J Class starting line will be shorter than the Pursuit Fleet starting line.

Delete and replace SI 16.1 with the following:

16.1 For Thursday races only, refer to Exhibit 10 for Windward / Leeward course configuration and buoy colors. For Friday, Saturday and Sunday coastal races, the finishing line will be between a staff displaying a large orange flag on the race committee signal boat and the course side of a yellow inflatable cylinder. The J Class finishing line will be shorter than the Pursuit Fleet finishing line.

J Class Sailing Instructions Exhibit 10 (Windward / Leeward Courses)

Add the following paragraph:

“The starting and finishing line will be between a staff displaying a large orange flag on the race committee signal boat and the course side of an orange inflatable cylinder.”

Delete and replace the last paragraph of Exhibit 10 with:

All marks will be yellow inflatable buoys with the exception of the starting and finishing pin buoys and the windward change mark, which will be orange inflatable buoys.
