## Sailing Instructions – Exhibit 6

Sailing Instructions Part II

8.2 Prior to arriving in the starting area, fully charged GPS tracker units shall be attached to each yacht in accordance with the GPS Tracker Instructions (SI Exhibit 6).

8.3 The GPS unit will track the yacht's course each day. Tracking will be live and available for replay after racing, providing an approximate record of course sailed and proximity to other yachts. The race committee will have a comprehensive record of every crossing, rounding or passing situation and be able to monitor the 40 meter minimum separation.

Please follow these procedures carefully:


- a. At registration, the RRS Safety Afterguard Member or Captain, shall receive and sign for their tracking device and charger. Every tracking device is provided with a 100/240V 50/60Hz micro USB charger.
- b. It is a RRS Safety Afterguard Member's responsibility to have the tracking device fully charged and properly mounted on the yacht before the start of racing each day.
- c. The tracking device, charger and aquapac must be returned to the race office as soon as practicable after the last race in the series.

Any yacht that fails to comply with these procedures may be subject to action by the organizer. Please return the tracking device and charger to the race office Immediately following the last race. In case of loss, the cost will be assessed.

## MOUNTING THE DEVICE

The tracking device should be placed into its aquapac (provided) and is recommended to be attached to the boat on the sea rail, ideally centrally, at the back of the boat, clear of any obstructions or other instruments, in clear view of the sky (for satellites) and above the Waterline.

Attach the device into position at the back of the boat. Secure with cable tie or tape, so it does not hang loosely or bang around. Once mounted correctly, do NOT open the water proof plastic bag under any circumstance – the **tracking device is NOT** waterproof.
