

Add NOR 11 k): RRS 60.2a(1) is changed as follows:

If the protestor is a boat, she shall inform the boat or boats involved by hailing protest along with the protested boat's name on VHF Channel 17 at the first reasonable opportunity. The protested boat shall, upon hearing the hail, acknowledge by responding to the hail. These actions shall be noted on the Daily Declaration Form for all boats involved. Should there be no response, communication by cellular telephone, WhatsApp or text message is encouraged. This changes RRS 60.2(a)1.

Add NOR 11 I): RRS Appendix T "Arbitration" will apply.

Add NOR 23.4:

Under World Sailing Rule DR21-01-V3.0, the definition Start is changed as follows:

Start A boat starts when her hull having been entirely on the pre-start side of the starting line, and having complied with rule 30.1 if it applies, any part of her hull crosses the starting line from the pre-start side to the course side either

- (a) at or after her starting signal, or
- (b) during the last three minutes before her starting signal.

When a boat starts in accordance with item (b) of the definition Start, she shall not return to the prestart side of the starting line and she shall be penalized by five minutes in addition to the amount of time she was on the course side of the starting line before her starting signal, added to her elapsed time without a hearing. Rule 29.1 will not apply. This changes rule A5.1.
