ON-WATER EMERGENCY PROCEDURES Sailing Instructions - Exhibit 10

The Bucket organizers, in conjunction with safety officials in St Barth, have established emergency procedures to provide help in the event of an on-the-water emergency, including injury requiring medical assistance. We also have emergency numbers should there be an accident or injury onshore.

- 1. Contact the race committee immediately on VHF 72 or VHF 17. If you are unable to contact the race committee, contact St Barths Sea Rescue (SBSR) on VHF Channel 16.
- 2. Identify your yacht, the nature of the emergency (type of injury, number of people injured), and your yacht's position.
- 3. The race committee or the SBSR will alert the Bucket on-water safety boats (which will also be monitoring VHF 72 and 17) and the appropriate personnel in St Barth and may direct you to another VHF channel or cell phone for further communication.
- 4. Proceed at best speed to Gustavia or a designated rendezvous point as directed.
- 5. Depending on the nature and severity of the injury, should this be the emergency, EMS personnel may come aboard your yacht to administer aid, evacuate the injured party, and/or re-direct you for transfer of the injured person.
- 6. You are asked to cooperate with any race committee, local law enforcement, and emergency personnel directives and instructions. St Barth's emergency telephone numbers are listed below.
- 7. Refer to the Sailing Instructions 20.1 for Man-Overboard (MOB) requirements.

Please take the time to review these procedures with your afterguard members prior to the first race.
