
Notice 6

Start Line Lat/Lon Positions via TracTrac

This is a replacement of Notice 4. The Lat/Lon position will NOT be provided in the chat, but rather displayed directly on the app display (see below). This will provide "real-time" updates on the start line positions.

Pinging the starting line ends (both the signal boat and pin) while other yachts are starting causes issues during pursuit format racing. Again this year we will be providing the starting flag on the signal boat and the pin locations to competitors via the TracTrac application.

The start line ends, orange flag on the signal boat, and the start pin location will be shared via TracTrac.



The TracTrac team has transponders on both the signal boat and the start pin. The TracTrac transponder will be attached to the hoist of the orange flag on the signal boat and a transponder will be attached to the top of the start pin. The location (lat/lon) of these transponders will be updated in the TracTrac app. The RC will announce when the Signal Boat and Pin are in location. The image here depicts a sample of the app display.

The TracTrac app information can be accessed either from an onboard computer at <u>http://www.tractrac.com</u> or via the mobile app which can be downloaded from either GooglePlay or the Apple App Store.
