THE BUCKET TROPHY

Second Criterion - Objective Component

The second criterion measures the competitiveness of each class.

The objective, quantitative criterion considers series points and overall time differential. The class with the closest series points and overall time differentials will earn the top objective competitive class score.

This considers series points and overall time differential

- The class with smallest series point differential between first and third place finishers will receive 1 point, with each class in succession receiving 2, 3, 4 or 5 points.
- The class with the smallest overall time differential (total time/total distance for all races) between the first and third place finishers will receive one point, with each class in succession receiving one additional point as above.

The above-mentioned points will be added together for the quantitative component of the criterion.
